

OUTSTANDING PUBLIC OFFICIAL AWARD

Award Description

This award recognizes significant and consistent contributions made by an Arizona public official (elected or appointed) at the federal, state, or local level in furthering the quality of life as it relates to the parks, recreation, and/or cultural needs of his/her Arizona constituents. The individual must hold elected or appointed office at the federal, state, or local level; they may be paid or a volunteer. Need not be a member of APRA.

Maximum Point Value	Criteria
30	Significant and consistent support of parks, recreation, and/or cultural services through strong leadership and/or legislative efforts.
30	Advocate of quality of life experiences as they relate to parks, recreation, and/or cultural services with demonstrated success resulting from that advocacy.
30	Impact of innovative leadership on the overall leisure opportunities for the population served.
10	Up to two pages of supplemental materials (8 1/2 x 11) may be submitted; supplemental pages are defined as news articles, photos, drawings, etc. which enhance understanding of the project. All supplemental information must be submitted in PDF Format.
